

**Carbon County
Municipal General Election Information
Election Day November 4, 2025**

All qualified, registered voters involved in a municipal election or special district board election will be mailed a ballot for the upcoming Municipal General Election (UCA 20A-3-305(1)(b)). **Ballots will be mailed between October 14 and October 28, 2025. All voted ballots must be in possession of the Clerk's Office on Election Day, November 4, 2025 by 8:00 p.m. This includes ballots returned by U.S. Mail or dropped into a ballot box.**
